Everything you need to know about the Gorbals Ideas Fund and our Your Priorities process for 2025



WHO ARE THE GORBALS IDEAS FUND?

The Gorbals Ideas Fund (GIF) are a group of local volunteers (Community Advocates) who believe local people should be more involved in deciding how money is spent in our community.



We use a process called Participatory Budgeting that gives local people much more control over how funding is spent to make the Gorbals an even better place to live.

Since we started, in 2018, we have been able to secure funds from the Scottish Government, National Lottery Scotland, Glasgow City Health and Social Care Partnership and others to support our work.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Until 2022 local people were mainly involved as voters deciding how small pots of funding would support local groups and organisations. In the first three years you helped distribute over £100,000 and supported over 70 new events, activities and services.

As we were recovering from the global pandemic in 2022 we thought it was the right time to involve local people as more than voters, we wanted you to have the chance to have your ideas funded!

In January 2025 we are launching Your Priorities, making £60,000 available to support the ideas of local people and £20,000 available to support ideas from groups and services.

YOUR PRIORITIES 2025

Your Priorities – 2025. It's a simple process that has been designed to give everyone the opportunity to share their ideas with other local people, or show support for other ideas that you think would bring something amazing to the Gorbals

There's a total of £80,000 available to support Your Priorities 2025, £60,000 for ideas from local people and £20,000 for ideas from local groups and services. You have until 16th January 2025 to post your ideas.

WHAT SORT OF IDEAS CAN I POST?

You can post ideas across two different topics:

1. Services, Groups & Activities

If you have an idea for something that could be delivered to the community like a weekly group or activity, or a service that people could access as and when they need it, post your idea in this topic.

2. Places & Spaces

If your idea relates to physical improvements to the area, for example, a park or a facility, post it in this topic.

WHAT IF THERE ARE SIMILAR IDEAS?

If we notice that two ideas are similar, we'll reach out to the people who posted them to explore the possibility of collaborating and combining their ideas.

If your idea aligns with something already happening in the community, we'll let you know and discuss how we can help move it forward.

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT...

The platform will be open to new ideas from **Thursday**5th December 2024 to Thursday 16th January 2025.

Once we've closed for new ideas, you'll have two weeks to rally support and get your community behind your vision! Encourage everyone to sign up for Your Priorities and help build momentum for your idea. This is your chance to make a real impact and improve your area—so let's get everyone involved and turn your idea into action. This phase runs from 16th January 2025 until 0th January 2025

Starting Friday, 31st January, the top 10 ideas from individuals and the top 10 from local groups (as voted on the Your Priorities platform) will advance to Stage 2. If your idea is one of the top 10, we'll invite you to work with us to develop and cost it. Once all ideas are developed and costed, they'll be taken back to the community for a final vote, which will run from Thursday, 6th March 2025 to Thursday, 20th March 2025.

THE IDEAS WITH THE MOST VOTES WILL BE FUNDED AND THAT'S WHEN WE REALLY START TO BRING YOUR IDEA TO LIFE!

The Gorbals is the only community in Scotland delivering participatory budgeting in this way, offering you a unique opportunity to make a real difference in the area where you live! That's why our motto is:

IDEAS | COMMUNITY | ACTION

DOES THIS REALLY WORK?

YES, IT DOES.

The process really does work and in 2022 almost 1000 local people got involved. We're working to develop the ideas you voted to fund in 2022 and you can find our more about these on page 6.



WHAT ELSE DO I NEED TO KNOW?

There are just two other, quite important, things we'd like you to know:

- 1. We fund ideas *not* individuals. If you post an idea and the community vote to fund it, that's the beginning of the development process which includes inviting other local people to be involved in deciding how the funds are spent to deliver the idea.
- 2. It isn't a quick fix. When we fund ideas we want them to be the very best they can be, we want them to last much longer than the funding they receive from the community and we're delighted to be able to offer that support, but this does take time.

GORBALS GROWS

What began as an idea from local residents has now taken root, thanks to £10,000 in funding from the Gorbals Ideas Fund, awarded by the community in 2022. This initiative is open to everyone



GORBALS ART GROUP

In October 2022, you awarded £5,750 to support the establishment of a new Gorbals Art Group. After two successful taster sessions, the project took a brief pause for reflection. We're in the process of reenergizing the group for 2025.



GORBALS COMMUNITY CINEMA

The idea for a Gorbals Community Cinema has received £10,000 in funding for the coming year, bringing the cinema experience directly to our community.



COMMUNITY FOOTBALL

You voted to support the Gorbals Community Football project, now NGE Grassroots Football, led by Craig Marshall. With £9,770 in funding, Craig is offering low-cost, pay-what-you-can football sessions for local young people, making sports accessible to all. The programme is off to a great start.



MOBILE WELLBEING HUB

In October 2022, you voted to fund a proposal for a mobile Wellbeing Hub in the Gorbals. Wellbeing Wednesday sessions launched on 29 March 2023 at the St Francis Centre and we're excited to continue developing this initiative in 2025.



GORBALS COMMUNITY PANTRY

Over 300 people voted to support the Gorbals Community Pantry, a great idea brought to us by long-time Gorbals resident and Poverty Truth Community Campaigner, Cath Wallace. Opening Early 2025.

A SPACE FOR THE GORBALS

Over the years, we've heard from many local residents about their priorities for the Gorbals, with a common theme being the need for more community spaces.

People want a central hub—a place to connect, chat, and stay informed about what's happening in the community.

Flexibility and accessibility are also key priorities, with a desire for a modern space that caters to the needs of people with physical or cognitive disabilities, as well as neurodiverse children and adults—one that is usable by everyone, from 0 to 100.

At our last Community Vote in October 2022, 66% of voters supported a campaign to address this need. You can read more about it in our blog!
